We lost the battle to protect our rights in the Supreme Court, and the justices have tried to limit the right to privacy in the Fourth Amendment with its surprising decision in *Carpenter v. U.S.* The Court held that officers could legally conduct a warrantless search of a house if the evidence was believed to be relevant in an unrelated investigation. Even though the Fourth Amendment says they can't do that, the Court found it can for all sorts of technical reasons. This case doesn't seem to be particularly concerning. But it is the type of issue that can slowly chip away at our freedom. With the Fourth Amendment about to take another hit, here are some simple things that you can do to protect your rights now. 1. Document police encounters. Record police encounters with you so that you have an accurate record of the encounter. If you are ever arrested or questioned by the police, record the whole thing. If you have a camera, take pictures. If you don't have a camera, call the police department or the county dispatch office and ask them to record the entire encounter. They might charge you for it, but it's a free record of the encounter. Use your smartphone or a voice recorder to record anything police tell you in the course of a search. It can be very difficult to prove that the police coerced you in any way, so you'd be wise to record all conversations with police. It is best to record conversations in a single sitting, so the police don't break the recording while they are questioning you.
